

Let's Begin

- 1. Visit: www.weebly.com
- 2. Click on "Sign Up" in the top right corner
- 3. Create your free account. Keep your password secure.
- 4. After your account is created, themes for your website will appear.
- 5. The themes listed under the "Personal" tab are easier to modify and gear towards classroom information. Select a theme of your choice from this section.



This theme is user friendly. The tabs at the top of the website are quick and easy to browse.

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

- 6. Begin customizing your site by selecting the "Start Editing" button on the top right corner.
- Choose a website domain (Name your site). You can choose your domain name last, and may opt to close this tab at this time if you choose.
- The website will provide you with a layout example.
 Everything on this template can be deleted and/or moved.
- 9. The entire website can be customized. On the left hand side, there is a grey area with many different features.
- 10. To choose features, click on the feature box you want, and drag it onto your website page.
- 1. Start with your home page. Provide information on your name, grade being taught, philosophy of education, and upcoming events. Add pictures to personalize.

- 12. On the page created for "Parents/Guardians" provide information and strategies they can use in order to successfully communicate and receive information about their son or daughters academic life.
- Create a tab for "Assignments" where in-class work with due dates, and homework assignments can be located. This provides students and parents with an online agenda.
- 14. The tab titled "More..." allows you to see any other tab created by hovering over it. The amount of tabs cannot be customized, therefore you must work with 4, and have the rest of your tabs found under the "More" tab. For example, you may choose to name other tabs as "Newsletter" and "Contact". The "Contact" tab allows parents to contact you via email to communicate any comments, questions, or concerns, in a quick and timely manner.
- 15. Web Tips: Personalize to suit your classroom needs. Try using large fonts, and non distracting backgrounds and keep each page clean and clutter free for easy readability.
